

## Criteria for qualification from IOQM 2024 to RMO 2024

1. A student has to score at least **10%** of the total marks of the IOQM 2024 paper in order to be eligible to appear for RMO 2024 but this is **NOT** the sole qualifying criterion.
2. Any student who has scored at least **10%** of the total marks of the IOQM 2024 paper and enrolled for IOQM 2024 as a student of one of the classes **8,9,10,11** will be classified as a **Category A** student.
3. Any student who has scored at least **10%** of the total marks of the IOQM 2024 paper and enrolled for IOQM 2024 as a student of class **12** will be classified as a **Category B** student.
4. The list of students who qualify for the RMO 2024 will be prepared according to the following rule:
  - (a) From each region (list of regions: <https://www.mtai.org.in/rmo-region-codes/>)
    - i. the top **200** students from **Category A** will qualify for RMO 2024 along with those tied in the 200<sup>th</sup> position;
    - ii. the top **40** students from **Category B** will qualify for RMO 2024 along with those tied in the 40<sup>th</sup> position;
    - iii. **5** additional girl students from **Category A** irrespective of the number of girl students qualifying in the top **200** students from **Category A** will qualify for RMO 2024 under **Girls' quota**.
  - (b) **There is no separate Girls' quota for Category B.** A girl student of **Category B** can qualify for RMO 2024 from IOQM 2024 if and only if she is selected among the top 40 students in **Category B** as described in the previous section (point 4(a)ii. above).
