## Criteria for qualification from IOQM 2024 to RMO 2024

- 1. A student has to score at least 10% of the total marks of the IOQM 2024 paper in order to be eligible to appear for RMO 2024 but this is **NOT** the sole qualifying criterion.
- 2. Any student who has scored at least 10% of the total marks of the IOQM 2024 paper and enrolled for IOQM 2024 as a student of one of the classes 8,9,10,11 will be classified as a Category A student.
- 3. Any student who has scored at least 10% of the total marks of the IOQM 2024 paper and enrolled for IOQM 2024 as a student of class 12 will be classified as a Category B student.
- 4. The list of students who qualify for the RMO 2024 will be prepared according to the following rule:
  - (a) From each region (list of regions: https://www.mtai.org.in/rmo-region-codes/)
    - i. the top **200** students from **Category A** will qualify for RMO 2024 along with those tied in the 200<sup>th</sup> position;
    - ii. the top **40** students from **Category B** will qualify for RMO 2024 along with those tied in the 40<sup>th</sup> position;
    - iii. 5 additional girl students from Category A irrespective of the number of girl students qualifying in the top 200 students from Category A will qualify for RMO 2024 under Girls' quota.
  - (b) There is no separate Girls' quota for Category B. A girl student of Category B can qualify for RMO 2024 from IOQM 2024 if and only if she is selected among the top 40 students in Category B as described in the previous section (point 4(a)ii. above).
